#### **SUNDAY, APRIL 28, 2019**

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of Easter DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Today we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. God's mercy is abundant and we can not measure the depth or length of God's mercy. His mercy is more than all the water in the oceans. Thomas, the apostle of Jesus, sees Jesus for the first time in today's gospel reading. Thomas was not with the other apostles when the risen Jesus appeared to the apostles for the first time. Thomas would not believe that Jesus rose from the dead unless he personally saw Christ. A week later the risen Jesus appears to the apostles again and this time Thomas is with them. "Now a week later his disciples were again inside and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, although the doors were locked, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be with you." Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands, and bring your hand and put it into my side, and do not be unbelieving, but believe." Thomas answered and said to him, "My Lord and my God!"

Jesus said to him, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." You and I are called to believe in the risen Christ although we do not have physical proof of his resurrection. Remember that Jesus' resurrection is central to our Catholic faith. If Jesus did not rise from the dead then our faith means nothing. In the weeks to come it will be the Easter season. Please rejoice and be glad. Alleluia, alleluia, alleluia! After the third absence due to work, the player is not permitted to play in a game until he/she returns to CCD class. All other reasons are unexcused.
