From the Desk of Fr. Tony Today the scribes and pharisees are testing Jesus, they approached Jesus and said, "Teacher, this woman was caught in the very act of committing adultery. Now in the law, Moses commanded us to stone such women. So, what do you say?" They said this to test him, so that they could have some charge to bring against him. Jesus bent down and began to write on the ground with his finger. But when they continued asking him, he straightened up and

said to them, "Let the one among you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." Again, he bent down and wrote on the ground. And in response, they went away one by one, beginning with the elders." These scribes and pharisees went away because they knew they were sinners also. They realized that they probably deserved to be punished also for their past sins. Each one of us are sinners. We all have disobeyed God and turned our back on God's commandments. But God in his great love has shown us forgiveness and mercy. We in turn are called to show mercy to others.

This woman caught in adultery was forgiven by Jesus but Jesus told her not to sin again. God forgives you and me but he wants us to refrain from committing the same sins over and over again. We have to put up some type of resistance to temptation. The one resistance that I find helpful is prayer. Prayer puts my mind and heart in a place of avoiding sin. When I find that I do not pray, I am easily tempted by sin. Prayer calms me down. Prayer puts in me a certain disgust with sin. You can't fight temptation without prayer and the sacraments. Basically, we need Jesus to stay away from evil. Self-help programs will help you avoid sin for a time but eventually those even fail without prayer. Fasting can also keep us from sin. Hang in there everyone. Easter is on the way. Don't give up now, you have come to far. God bless you all. Fr. Tony
