READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY September 4

Wis 9:13-18b Phlm 9-10, 12-17 Lk 14:25-33

From the Desk of Fr. Matt

I think we can all agree on the importance of being humble. At the same time, I think we can get confused on what it means to be humble. Sometimes I think we understand being humble as devaluing ourselves. Take for example when you something good or perhaps you have a gift for doing something. And somebody notices and gives genuine complement for what you do, and you respond by saying "it was nothing anybody could do it." You are right it was nothing, anybody can do what you did, a matter of a fact others can do what you did even better. To

devalue ourselves and to downplay the gifts that we have to offer to the world is not an act of humility. Nor is it humility to brag and to gloat about the gifts and talents that we have to give to the world. It is humble to accept the fact and know the gifts we have to give to the world, it is humble receive a complement for doing a good job and to say thank you in return. It is humble to accept, to know that you have value.

Being humble is not about devaluing oneself, nor is it about bragging about oneself, being humble it about being comfortable in one's skin and accepting yourself for who you are and what you have to give to the world. It is humility recognizing the need to improve an area of one's life. It humble in recognizing the gifts that others have to give to the world and supporting and encouraging them to share their gifts.

In our scriptures today Jesus gives us a lesson on how to be humble. Jesus instructs "When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, do not recline at table in the place of honor. A more distinguished guest than you may have been invited 'Rather, when you are invited, go and take the lowest place." (Luke 14:8,10). Jesus instructs to take the lowest place so that you can be invited to assume a higher place. This seems to imply that you are going to get invited to take a higher place but what happens if the invitation never comes to take a higher place? Or if the invitation to take a higher place is long delayed, perhaps maybe to the dessert course? Can we accept to stay where we are? Regardless of what our status, I think each one of us has dreams of being called up to a higher place and we think we know the benefits that come with getting called to the higher place. But from whatever would seem to be our lower place do we see how we are being blessed?

George Washington Carver was an African American and he is the scientists that is credited with developing peanuts for human consumption. He told the story:

When I was young, I said to God, 'God, tell me the mystery of the Universe.' But God answered. 'That knowledge is reserved for Me alone.' So I said, 'God, tell me the mystery of the peanut.' Then God said, 'Well George, that's more nearly your size.' And he told me. ¹

What is that small peanut that the Lord is calling you to work with?
