Jer 38:4-6, 8-10 Heb 12:1-4 Lk 12:49-53

From the Desk of Fr. Matt In our scriptures today we are given a definition of what faith is "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen" (Hebrews 11:1). As I sit and write this reflection, I write anticipating attending my high school class reunion this weekend. As I look forward to catching up with high school classmates, I also think about how faith has played a part in my life, and how faith has also played apart my classmates' lives, and all of our lives as well. After graduating from high school, I sensed that God might be calling me to the

priesthood, but I had questions, how I would handle the academic work necessary to become a priest, I was a little social award and shy not necessarily the best qualities for a priest. Was God really calling me to the priesthood? Yet I entered seminary with faith. Since graduation faith has also played a part in my classmates lives careers, jobs, marriages, becoming parents, and various other aspects of life. Those who have recently graduated from high school are getting ready to take step of faith as they prepare to go off to and/or start college and/or a career. Every day we take steps of faith some big and others not as big. Often, we speak of concerns of losing faith at this stage in life. I like to think we do not lose our faith rather I think we put our faith in the wrong places, other people, or ourselves rather than putting our faith in the Lord. Are we putting our faith in the Lord? When we have our faith in the Lord, we can do anything but when our faith is elsewhere, we are bound to fail.

I think of the example of when Jesus walked on water. In this story Peter says "Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water.' He said, 'Come.'" (Matthew 14:28-29). Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on water. When Peter took his eyes off Jesus and became aware of where he was, Peter began to sink and cried out for Jesus to help him. In this moment Peter put his faith in something else and nearly drowned. At times we can also put our faith in something other than the Lord and nearly drown as well. Like Peter we call out to Jesus and Jesus saves us.

In our scriptures today Abraham is credited with being a man of faith and he was. Abraham when his wife Sarah was barren and old, Abraham was called by God to leave his father's land, for a promised land that God would point out to him and here God would bless him with descendants beyond his counting. This plan may have sounded crazy yet Abraham goes with faith and God blesses Abraham with descendants beyond his counting. But what we can so easily forget is there are examples of Abraham putting his faith in someone else. For example, in Gerar when to save his life, Abraham said that Sarah was his sister. So, the king takes Sarah and God comes to the king and says that he going to die because Sarah was married.

Like Peter and Abraham, we put our faith in our God and at different moments we can put our faith in someone than our God. My journey to the priesthood was about having my faith in God and at different moments I put my faith in other places, and it felt like I was drowning, I called out to Jesus to help me. Perhaps you are in one of those moments right now repent and "cry out Lord help". As you call out for help may you reaffirm your faith in our God.
