DECEMBER 22, 2019 4th Sunday of Advent

We hear from Matthew in today's gospel, "When his mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found with child through the Holy Spirit. Joseph her husband, since he was a righteous man, yet unwilling to expose her to shame, decided to divorce her quietly. Such was his intention when, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David,

do not be afraid to take Mary your wife into your home. For it is through the Holy Spirit that this child has been conceived in her. She will bear a son and you are to name him Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."

This gospel is a good example that we have to make up our minds and go with our best thinking. Joseph made up his mind to divorce Mary quietly. At first Joseph did not believe that Mary got pregnant through the Holy Spirit. But then an angel of the Lord came to Joseph in a dream and told Joseph to take Mary into his home. We have to make up our minds but we have to be open to the Holy Spirit at the last moment. This is how God works at times. Are we humble enough to change our minds? Is our hearts open to God or do we only do what we want, what is the easiest route?
