**DECEMBER 5, 2021
2nd Sunday of Advent**

Today we hear John the Baptist speaking to the people. John is fulfilling Isaiah's prophecy, "A voice of one crying out in the desert: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths." During this time of advent, we are preparing our hearts for Christ. You could say that we are doing John the Baptist's work in Glandorf and around the world.
