SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2022

8th Sunday of Ordinary Time

Jesus tells us today, "Why do you notice the splinter in your brother's eye, but do not perceive the wooden beam in your own? How can you say to your brother, 'Brother, let me remove that splinter in your eye,' when you do not even notice the wooden beam in your own eye?" Jesus is encouraging us to work on our own problems and be merciful with others and their problems. We can not go walking around like we are Mr. and Mrs. Perfect. It is important that we approach people with humility knowing that each one of us is a sinner and beset with our own failings and weaknesses.

This week is Ash Wednesday and it is a time to look seriously at our own weaknesses and sin. I encourage all of you to enter this Lenten season with the understanding that we will not always overcome our sinful behavior. I can try all I want to divert my behavior from sin but I will fall during this time of repentance. The main thing is that you do not give up. You may want to go to confession not once but maybe two or three times during lent. Do not have the mind set, "This sin is bigger than me, I might as well realize that this sin will plague me the rest of my life." You are correct in saying that this sin can conquer you, but with Jesus, you can get rid of any demons in your life.

Pray together as a family. Instead of thinking of yourself, turn to others in their needs and serve them. Go to bed at night exhausted from service. God will renew your strength each morning. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday eat only one meal that day. Jesus does talk about fasting in the scriptures. Some demons are not expelled from us because we do not pray and fast. Lent is what you put into it. There is an old high school cheer, "You can do it, you can do it, if you put your mind to it, buckle down, buckle down, do it, do it, do it." God bless you all. Fr. LENTEN REGULATIONS The cross † of ashes which Christians receive on our foreheads is a sign of our mortality and of the Lord's invitation to enter into this 40-day time of prayer, penance and inner conversion. While the entire Lenten season is one of conversion from the penance for sin, certain days of Lent are marked with a special penitential character as days of fast and abstinence.

The church's Lenten regulations are as follows:

1. Ash Wednesday, March 2 and Good Friday, April 10, are days of abstinence from meat and days of fast.

The law of abstinence is binding on all Catholics 14 years of age and older. The law of fasting is binding on all Catholics 18 to 59. On a fast day, only one full meal may be eaten and eating between meals is forbidden. Together, other meals eaten should not equal more than a full meal. Those who are over 60 yrs. of age, the sick, or persons who for other serious reasons should not reduce their food intake, are dispensed from the obligation to fast. In doubt, consult your priest.

2. All the Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.

The obligation to do penance is a serious one; the obligation to observe, as a whole or "substantially", the penitential days specified by the Church is also serious. No one should be scrupulous in this regard; failure to observe an individual day of penance is not considered serious. People should seek to do more rather than less. Fast and abstinence on the days prescribed above should be considered a minimum response to the Lord's call to penance.
