SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 28 2nd Sunday of Lent

Today we see the transfiguration of Christ on Mount Tabor. Jesus brings Peter, James, and John with him to this mountain. These three apostles see Jesus speaking with the Old Testament figures Moses and Elijah. Jesus is actually levitating with Moses and Elijah on each side of him. This is a spectacle to see for Peter, James, and John. They are actually seeing Jesus speak to people, Moses and Elijah, who died long ago. Jesus is also dressed in dazzling white. This is a miracle meant to help the apostle's belief in Christ. Then a voice comes from the clouds, "This is my beloved son. Listen to him." We all need to listen to Christ. We know he is the messiah, the son of God, who came to take away the sins of the world. Christ came into the world to destroy sin and death so we can be with him forever and not chained to sin. Jesus is an enemy of sin. He does not like it and he does not like it when we participate in it. You and I have to have the same disdain for sin as Christ does.
