

From the Desk of Fr. Tony

JANUARY 23, 2022

3rd Sunday of Ordinary Time

In the first reading today we hear from Nehemiah and Ezra, "Then Nehemiah, that is, His Excellency, and Ezra the priest-scribe and the Levites who were instructing the people said to all the people: "Today is holy to the LORD your God. Do not be sad, and do not

weep"— for all the people were weeping as they heard the words of the law. He said further: "Go, eat rich foods and drink sweet drinks, and allot portions to those who had nothing prepared; for today is holy to our LORD. Do not be saddened this day, for rejoicing in the LORD must be your strength!"

As Christians we must be a happy and joyful people. Sure, there is much to make us sad in the world but we can

not let the world get to us. The people of Israel were sad in today's first reading but Nehemiah and Ezra encouraged the people to press on and do not let one's feelings control them. Our feelings are up and down like

a yo yo. Sometimes we have to rejoice when we don't want to. Think of all the blessings we have at this time. Sure, we may not have gotten the job promotion we wanted but look at all you do have. You have a family, shelter, clothing, food, and your family's love. Once you take the time to recall all your blessings, it will not take long for you to get out of a saddened slump.

Dr. Merrill Raye died last week and he had a card which is titled, "The way to happiness." It says, "Keep your heart free from hate, your mind from worry, live simply, Trust God, and thank God for all of your blessings." This takes effort on our part. It is a purposeful mind set. If after office hours, call the Sheriff's Dept. at 419-523-3208 or 419-523-5346. They have a beeper number to contact a caseworker after office hours. The person who witnessed or was told is to be the person to make the call. The supervisor (Business Manager, Coordinator of Rel. Ed. High School, Rel. Ed. Elementary, Preschool or Youth Group) can be present if requested. When appropriate, next call parents and notify pastor if not already notified. If abuse is by a teacher, parish staff, or volunteer, report incident to Diocese of Toledo after County Caseworker has been notified.
