

JANUARY 26, 2020

3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus speaks to Peter and Andrew today and says, "Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men." At once they left their nets and followed him. He walked along from there and saw two other brothers, James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They were in a boat, with their father Zebedee, mending their nets. He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed him." Jesus is in the inviting mode now. He is starting his ministry and he needs people close to him to teach and be with. Jesus is God but even God likes human companionship. We are the body of Christ and the body of Christ does things and learns together. Jesus is not a lone ranger and he does not expect his disciples to be lone rangers also.
