**JANUARY 30, 2022
4th Sunday of Ordinary Time**

In today’s first reading from Jeremiah, we see that the people of Judah fight against Jeremiah the prophet. The reason the people of Judah are upset with Jeremiah is because he spoke against the hypocrisy of his Jewish religion. He saw people pursuing political advancement in religion. He saw backstabbing and lying amongst his people. But the Lord assures Jeremiah, “They will fight against you but not prevail over you, for I am with you to deliver you, says the LORD.” This same type of assurance is with us if we but love others from the heart. Paul speaks to us in the second reading. Love is patient, kind, and not pompous. Love does not seek its own interest but the interest of the other.

In the gospel today, we see that Jesus is in the same situation as Jeremiah was. Jesus points out the lack of faith of the Israelites. This infuriates the people. Jesus is not accepted amongst his own people and they want to throw him off the cliff. But Jesus passes through his kin because his time of death was not at hand. Jesus is in control of his own death. He will not die until it is his time. At times we stand alone and there is no one to back us up but God. Jeremiah and Jesus knew what it was to have a crowd against them. But both of them had trust in God. Are you willing to stand with God and point out the injustices of your time? God will back you up. People will fight against you but not prevail because God is not with liars and evil doers. God bless you all.
