JANUARY 5, 2020 Epiphany of the Lord

In the past couple of weeks, we have seen many miracles. We see the virgin giving birth to the Christ. We see Joseph being told by an angel in a dream to take Mary as his wife. We see the wise men in today's gospel being warned in a dream not to return to King Herod. These instances tell me that God is trying to interact with his people.

Do we allow God to speak to us and interact with us during the week? I know that God speaks to us through scripture, through our thoughts, through other people and in our dreams. It is hard to remember dreams if you do not write them down on paper. I know that some people, including myself, dismiss dreams quickly. But God could be sending messages to us in our sleep. Try putting a paper and pencil by your bed and write down your dream in detail. You may learn something.

From the moment of Jesus' birth, evil was trying to destroy the Christ. Evil is trying to destroy us Christians also. We are followers of Christ so evil and our own desire for sin can destroy us. I often pray to St. Gaspar del Buffalo. He was born on the feast of the Epiphany. He was named after the three wise men, Gaspar, Melchior, Balthazar, del Buffalo. St. Gaspar was the founder of the Precious Blood community. Fr. Matt, Fr. Rick, Br. Jerry, Fr. Mark, and myself belong to this community. With Jesus' help, we are to continue to fight against evil.
