

Come join us for Mass at the Shrine celebrating the Feast of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel on Thursday Evening, July 16th at 7:00pm

It is on this day in about 1386 that **Our Lady** appeared to St. Simon Stock. She gave him a Brown Scapular saying, "Take, beloved son this scapular of thy order as a badge of **my** confraternity and for thee and all Carmelites a special sign of grace; whoever dies in this garment, will not suffer everlasting fire."

Following Mass: We will bring Our Lady of Fatima's Traveling Statue forward and then

Fr. Tony will lead us in the Rosary.

If you would like to bring **a flower or flowers** to lay before Our Lady of Fatima's Statue this night, feel free to bring them with you and place them by her statue inside the gate to the Shrine.

There were two other major messages and lessons Our Lady gave us on October 13, 1917. These have to do with how she identified herself as Our Lady of the Rosary and how she appeared during the miracle as Our Lady of Mount Carmel with a scapular. The message was clear. "Yes, the Rosary and the scapular are inseparable," Sister Lucia confirmed during an interview with two Carmelite priests. (Taken from Soul Magazine, Summer 2017)

From the Desk of Fr. Tony

SUNDAY, JULY 12 2020 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus says, "Hear then the parable of the sower. The seed sown on the path is the one who hears the word of the kingdom without understanding it, and the evil one comes and steals away what was sown in his heart. The seed sown on rocky ground is the one who hears the word and receives it at once with joy. But he has no root and lasts only for a time. When some tribulation or persecution comes because of the word,

he immediately falls away. The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word, but then worldly anxiety and the lure of riches choke the word and it bears no fruit. But the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold."

It is not difficult to hear God's word but to keep that word in our hearts is another story. The devil is always trying to get our attention and always trying to divert us away from Christ. Satan sends anxieties of daily life our way. He is always trying to get us away from Christ's word. Satan does not want you to pray. He does not want you to spend one second in God's word. "The seed sown among thorns is the one who hears the word, but then worldly anxiety and the lure of riches choke the word and it bears no fruit." But when we spend time with God and his word and in front of the tabernacle, we come to know Christ. "But the seed sown on rich soil is the one who hears the word and understands it, who indeed bears fruit and yields a hundred or sixty or thirtyfold." He understands God's word because he spends time with his word. He wastes time with Jesus. He establishes the self-discipline of prayer each day. Talking to God and God talking to him. If we do not enter into prayer each day, we will not represent Christ when the going gets tough. Why? Because we have not invested any time with Christ. Would you defend what you have not spent time with? You have no vested interest. Create roots for Christ in your heart. Time with Christ allows your roots to go deep into the mystery of God's soil. You then will be able to laugh at the tribulations the world sends to you. God bless you all. Fr. Tony



ANNOUNCEMENT: Playing any sports this year? You are expected to attend both the Fall & Winter sessions of High School Religious Education Groups or Grade School CCD Classes---plus weekend Saturday or Sunday Mass. This includes all players, coaches and their families. Attendance at these groups/classes will be monitored and reviewed. For each class missed (which is not an excused absence) you will be sitting out one game.—To play CYO sports, the following are the only excused absences from CCD: sickness, death in family, college visitation day, parish sponsored event, sport tournament games only with O-G athletes/fans involved, and work (up to 3 missed CCD classes due to work). After the third absence due to work, the player is not permitted to play in a game until he/she returns to CCD class. All other reasons are unexcused. Parents, if your child is sick, please call his/her teacher/leader before class. If necessary, the Parish Council will review attendance or unexcused absence issues on an individual basis.
