## SUNDAY, JULY 26 2020 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's first reading from first Kings, the Lord appears to Solomon and tells Solomon to ask for anything. Solomon asks for wisdom to rule over his people Israel. Solomon receives this wisdom and proves that God has given him a great gift. People are amazed at Solomon's decision making. People come from a far to experience and speak to Solomon.

Solomon experiences peace in his days as king of Israel but his wisdom eventually sways to a bad place. Solomon eventually starts worshipping false gods and he has many wives. When we do not stay focused on the Lord then we start turning to the dark side. Solomon is proof of that.

Jesus tells us today, "Thus it will be at the end of the age. The angels will go out and separate the wicked from the righteous and throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth." If you are wicked and are six foot and seven inches and three hundred and forty pounds an angel of God will pick you up and throw you around like a rag doll. That tells you how strong and mighty God's angels are. Your physical stature means nothing to Christ. Your Christ like heart means everything to Jesus. Your struggle on earth is not with the mighty on earth. Your struggle is with Satan and his traps. Do you understand that? Are you willing to stay by Christ's side by reading his word each day and praying for his mother's intercession? That is a struggle. ### PARISH POLICY FOR CYO HIGH SCHOOL & PUTNAM COUNTY GRADE SCHOOL BOY'S & GIRL'S SPORTING TEAMS

ANNOUNCEMENT: Playing any sports this year? You are expected to attend both the Fall & Winter sessions of High School Religious Education Groups or Grade School CCD Classes---plus weekend Saturday or Sunday Mass. This includes all players, coaches and their families. Attendance at these groups/classes will be monitored and reviewed. For each class missed (which is not an excused absence) you will be sitting out one game.—To play CYO sports, the following are the only excused absences from CCD: sickness, death in family, college visitation day, parish sponsored event, sport tournament games only with O-G athletes/fans involved, and work (up to 3 missed CCD classes due to work). After the third absence due to work, the player is not permitted to play in a game until he/she returns to CCD class. All other reasons are unexcused. Parents, if your child is sick, please call his/her teacher/leader before class. If necessary, the Parish Council will review attendance or unexcused absence issues on an individual basis.
