#### **READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY August 7**

Wis 18:6-9 Heb 11:1-2, 8-19 Lk 12:32-48



"They say in life that there only two things that are guaranteed paying taxes and death. Both paying taxes and death are guaranteed and in our American Culture we tend to do everything that we can to avoid the two guarantees of life. It is said that it is our patriotic duty to pay taxes and the unwritten rule of paying our taxes is to do what you can so that you can pay as little of taxes as you can.

We exercise, we eat healthy, we get proper sleep, we try to keep our stress levels down, and we many other things to take care of our bodies with the hope of avoiding death. The subject of death is one of those subjects that makes us feel uncomfortable, and we avoid talking about it. Somehow, we have the mindset to believe that by doing the right things and not doing wrong things, and not talking about death, we can avoid death. However, there is no avoidance of death, one day our bodies are going to physically die. Our scriptures today

affirm this reality "Here is one who has labored with wisdom and knowledge and skill, and yet another who has not labored over it, he must leave property" (Ecclesiastes 2:21). Both the wise and the unwise die.

While we may not be able to avoid this reality of death, our faith also teaches us that we are to take care of our bodies, we are called to want what is best for our lives. We are called to live our lives to the fullest. We do not seek death, but we called to be ready for that moment.

An idea that we hear repeated in our scriptures is that when we die our property is left behind or the rich man is asked "the things you have prepared, to whom will they belong?" (Luke 12:20). When we think of things being left behind our instinct is to think of physical belongings. I think of after my grandparents passed away of going through their houses and dividing their stuff among the family and I have several items from them that I keep in their memory. Stuff gets left behind and some of the stuff that gets left behind has value sentimental and/or market value. But you know the most important/valuable things that get left behind are not material items. It is family and the impact that we have on others that is the most important things of value that we leave behind. Have you ever noticed most obituaries mentions the deceased's family members, the things the deceased did and said, very rarely does the obituary mention the stuff owned? Perhaps maybe if they owned an antique car and restored it. So, the question for us how are we making our impact on the world?

"Thus, will it be for all who store up treasure for themselves but are not rich in what matters to God" (Luke 12:21). The rich man in our scriptures had a bountiful harvest that he could have shared with the world and rather than sharing that treasure with the world, he chose to build larger barns, and keep his treasure to himself. Rather we are called to continually be using are gifts to make our world better. How are you being called to share your treasure with the world?
