#### **READINGS FOR NEXT SUNDAY July 3 (Feast of the Precious Blood)**

Exodus 24:3-8 Ephesians: 2:13-20 Lk 22:14-20

From the Desk of Fr. Tony

In the gospel today, we see Jesus interacting with the people. "And to another he said, "Follow me." But he replied, "Lord, let me go first and bury my father." But he answered him, "Let the dead bury their dead. But you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God." And another said, "I will follow you, Lord, but first let me say farewell to my family at home." To him Jesus said, "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God."

Jesus is telling us that the kingdom of God must be preached and it takes precedence over all people and all institutions. A man wants to bury his father before he follows Jesus. Jesus said "Let the dead bury their dead."

But you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God." God's kingdom has to be preached and taught to the world. Another person wants to say farewell to his family before he follows Jesus. But Jesus tells this person not to look back but go forward and follow him.

The temptation for me will be to look back in my rearview mirror when I leave Glandorf. I can't. You and I must keep pressing forward. We do our work and God nourishes what we have done. Fr. Matt will take good care of this parish. He knows what is expected of him. Remember everyone is involved in the work of spreading Christianity. Just not the priests and deacons. St. Gaspar said, "We have much to do because Jesus expects us to do it. We must spread the gospel quickly and work tirelessly for the gospel. Because God's people are deserving of it."
