





From the Desk of Fr. Tony

MARCH 1, 2020 FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

We begin the first Sunday of Lent today. In the gospel we see Jesus being tempted by Satan. Satan tries to tempt Jesus so you know he is going to tempt you and me, who are the followers of Jesus. Jesus passes Satan's tempting test. Notice Satan comes around when Jesus is weak from fasting for forty days. Satan will

come to us when we are weak.

When we say, "In Jesus' name Satan be gone," we then have power over Satan. But if we say, "Satan be gone," he will not listen to us. Jesus tells Satan, "Get away, Satan! It is written:

The Lord, your God, shall you worship and him alone shall you serve. "Then the devil left him and, behold, angels came and ministered to him. Notice that we only worship and serve God. He is our utmost importance. When we pray to God, we can endure the temptations that the devil throws at us. But if we do not pray to God, we are easy pickens for the devil. We have put a bull's eye on our back by being baptized and by being a follower of Christ. Lent is a time to allow oneself to enter into particular and intentional spiritual training. What we do now, extra prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, will strengthen our resolve and soul. On the back of the Putnam County Sheriff's cars you read, "With God all things are possible." It is true.
