MARCH 15, 2020 THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Today's gospel is the "Woman at the well." Jesus meets a Samaritan woman at the well and Jesus tells her about her life. She is amazed that Jesus knows so much about her. Jesus knows all people. He is God. You cannot hide anything from him. Jesus is really, really, really watching you each day of your life. During this time of lent God is asking us to

work on our relationship with him. Don't worry about other people. Many times, we do not have to get into other people's business. Taking care of our own souls and behavior is enough to occupy us. Take the beam out of your own eye before you take the splinter out of another person's eye. Work on you! Lent is a time to work on you and your behavior. When we do interact with others it is to be their servant and that is it. We do not tear people down, we lift them up.

Jesus wants many people to come to him to be saved. Ask yourself, "Since lent has started have I been praying more? Giving to others my time and talent? Have I repented to God?" We need to repent. Noah and Jonah teach us that repentance is nothing new for God's people. We are God's people so we have to repent and go to the sacrament of reconciliation. You may say, "Don't tell me what to do."
