## MARCH 31, 2019 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Lent

In today's gospel we hear Jesus' parable of the prodigal son. This younger son is wasteful and he does not care about his father and his family. This younger son only cares about what he wants. We see that this younger son wants the share of his inheritance. His father gives it to him and the younger son immediately wastes his inheritance on a life of dissipation and prostitutes. The younger son finds himself caught in a famine. He is hungry and in need. He returns home

and his father welcomes him instead of being angry with him.

I was watching a golfing tournament several years ago in Dublin, Ohio. As I was walking through the country club I saw Johnny Bench, the famous Cincinnati Red baseball player. He was talking to an individual and as I walked by him he said something to the effect, "You do not want to burn your bridges." You do not want to make enemies in this life. You never know when you may need their help or assistance. At times we find ourselves in difficult positions. Maybe we do not plan for the future or terrible things, diseases, illness, or loss of job become a part of our situation.

This gospel is about God's mercy and forgiveness. The father shows compassion and forgiveness towards his son. But how can we be compassionate and forgiving to those we encounter every day? How can we not burn our bridges? This time of lent calls us to prayer. Prayer makes us a gentler and forgiving people. Prayer helps us to stick to our morals and ethics.
