Today Jesus becomes upset. People are not respecting the holiness of the temple. “He made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the temple area, with the sheep and oxen, and spilled the coins of the money changers and overturned their tables, and to those who sold doves he said, “Take these out of here, and stop making my

Father’s house a marketplace.”

When we become accustomed to objects or people, we ignore their sacredness. That is what is happening in today’s gospel. The people are very accustomed to the temple so they eventually make it into a marketplace. I do not have mass near the checkout line at Walmart or Kohls. People would just walk by me when I would be saying the words of consecration. I would have to use the checkout counter for an altar. When something is holy or has been consecrated to God, we do not treat it like a piece of meat or a pen you write with. I don’t use my chalice at mass for a cup to drink Pepsi out of. Anything that has been blessed needs to be burned or buried. Like old broken rosaries and scapulars. I know it takes effort but we have to reverence the holy. When we come up for communion at mass, we have to realize what we are receiving. We can’t normalize everything we encounter. God wants us to reverence Him and reverence Him in other people. Whenever we see another person, we are seeing a soul that will live for all eternity. God bless you all. Fr. Tony
