What are Endowment Funds?

Endowment funds are an investment in our future. The interest from an Endowment is used to financially support the programs and services as outlined in the diocese's case for support. As you personally save for the future, so too must the Diocese of Toledo. By raising funds today, we will maintain the vitality of our diocese for this generation and beyond.

By raising funds to support Seminary Education, this endowment will subsidize a portion of the annual costs of educating our current seminarians in formation, while also securing necessary funding to support the annual costs of forming our future priests.

Endowments will also be established to provide resources and training for those who form our Catholic school students as well as young adult and campus ministries.

Breakdown of Living Christ Campaign

- □ St. John the Baptist Parish will receive 35% of all funds up to our goal raised to construct a new staircase to the Choir Loft and replace the concrete and reconfigure the handicap parking on the north side of the church.
- St. John Parish will receive 50% of all dollars raised over our campaign goal of \$820,000.
- Of the 65% of the campaign funds going to Diocese of Toledo's programs and capital needs, 85% of the funds will be placed in Endowments Funds.
