WE ARE LIVING CHRIST!

Today we kick off the Living Christ Campaign at St. John the Baptist. Our parish's participation in the campaign, along with all 122 parishes in the Diocese of Toledo, will meet needs of our parish and support Catholic ministries in our 19 counties of Northwest Ohio. This is an exciting and much needed effort that will benefit so many people throughout our community!

Our goal is to raise \$820,000 in pledges payable over five (5) years from our parish families. Thirty-five percent of the funds from these pledges will go toward the parish needs listed on the right. The remaining funds are for capital and endowment needs supporting the following priorities:

- Strengthening our Parishes
- · Supporting our Clergy
- Caring for the Poor
- · Fostering Emerging Disciples
- · Restoring Our Mother Church
- · Forming Our Lay Leaders

When you receive your invitation to consider pledging to the campaign, please pray about making a commitment that is sacrificial over the 5-year pledge period. In the mean-time, we ask you to join us in praying for the success of the *Living Christ* Campaign.



With Saint John's share of the funds raised in this campaign effort, we will construct a new staircase to the choir loft and also replace the concrete and reconfigure the handicap parking on the north side of the Church.

After many months of careful prayer and planning, the Diocese of Toledo is embarking upon a major fundraising campaign. - Restoring Our Mother Church Tending to the capital and maintenance needs of Our Lady, Queen of the Most Holy Rosary Cathedral, the Mother Church of our diocese.
- Forming Our Lay Leaders Enhancing lay leadership capabilities for service in the Church through education, training, and skill development.


