## November 17, 2019 Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's gospel Jesus tells us that some of us will be persecuted for Christ's name. He says, "Remember, you are not to prepare your defense beforehand, for I myself shall give you a wisdom in speaking that all your adversaries will be powerless to resist or refute. You will even be handed over by parents, brothers, relatives, and friends, and they will put

some of you to death. You will be hated by all because of my name, but not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

This life with Christ is not for the faint hearted. Christ tells us that when we are being persecuted and led before governors, kings, or those in authority, we are not to prepare our defense beforehand. God will give us a wisdom to stand firm. I know many of us want to be prepared if we are called to stand trial but God will give you the words you are to speak. Do you trust him? If you do, then you have to practice now in listening to that voice inside of you. God does speak to us each day. How do you know if it is God's voice? Compare the answer you get with the gospel message. If your thoughts turn to selfishness, pride, or jealousy, then those thoughts are not from Christ. But if your thoughts turn to love, mercy, and selflessness, then it is God speaking to you.

Jesus tells us not to follow false prophets. False prophets only look to themselves and their own fame. False prophets contradict the gospel message. Do not follow them. God bless you all. Fr. Tony
