Kindergarten Registration Scheduled for the 2022 - 2023 school year will be held during parent/teacher conferences in the school office. The registration will be on **Thursday**, **November 18 or Monday**, **November 22**, from 5:00-8:00pm and on **Tuesday**, **November 23**, from 9:00am-3:00pm. Parents are asked to bring their child's birth certificate, social security number, a record of immunizations and proof of residency (i.e. utility bill, voter registration card, lease agreement or real estate tax duplicate) to the registration.
