

ST. JOHN PARISH JOINT COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES May 19, 2022

Voted for New Parish Council Positions and they are as follows:

Handicap Driveway - At this point, we are at 84% of the Diocesan campaign with over \$120,000 of the money in, so there was discussion if we could tell The Concrete Couple to get started on this project. Motion: Give the go-ahead to The Concrete Couple, through K&L concrete, to replace concrete on the North side of church for the handicap parking and the spaces would be re-configured. The motion was by Brian Grimes. It was seconded by Tara Gerding. Motion passed.

Church Choir Loft- TDG had an architect come to the council meeting to explain the staircase proposals to the councils. Everyone walked to the church to envision where the proposed ideas would be constructed. There was a lot of discussion and concerns in which the council made no decisions and the options were not favorable. Further detail, and more exploratory options are needed before any type of decision would be made. The council members agreed that the safety is a priority and also the integrity of the church needs to be preserved along with making sure little to no seating would be removed if the project moves forward. Other options are being explored.

Updates/New Business: Wedding rentals were discussed and the reasons to allow wedding receptions and not to allow wedding receptions in the parish center. It was brought up that we do not have the staff or the control on the building during wedding receptions, there is a greater chance of needing maintenance etc. during a wedding reception vs. a rental in the cafeteria. The control on the building is an issue and accountability during the reception. Underage bar tenders, inappropriate music and dancing were all discussed and those acts do not follow what we teach in that building on a regular basis. We have looked into cleaning companies with no luck. We have thought about hiring a parish center coordinator but decided at this time we are not sure we would even find anyone wanting to take on that during the weekends. The council decided to put a hold on wedding receptions in the parish center starting in 2024 until further notice. The council all voted on the motion. It was motioned by Brian Grime. It was seconded by Tim Hoehn. Motion passed.
