Jesus tells us today, "No servant can serve two masters. He will either hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and mammon." You cannot serve both God and money at the same time. Brother Hue Henderson C.P.P.S. used to say, "You're going to serve someone in this life. It might be the devil or it might be the Lord but you are going to serve someone." Who do we want to serve in this life? Our daily decisions determine our devotion and allegiance.

You can tell when people do not want to have anything to do with you. They usually get away from you as soon as they can. People may say that they love Jesus but will not spend one minute listening to his word or one second with a person in need. People may say they love Jesus but will not spend time with the unpopular or the outcast of a community. Jesus tells us to associate with the outcast and the unpopular. Do we only love Jesus when it is popular and when we will not get persecuted for standing with Christ?

Remember this; if you are not serving Christ then you are serving the devil. Jesus said, "You are either with me or against me. You are either gathering or scattering." There is no middle ground in allegiance to Christ. God bless you all. Fr. Tony
