AUGUST 1, 2021 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Like last week, we see that Jesus is the fulfillment of the Old Testament and the prophets. Last week in the Old Testament, the prophet fed one hundred people but Jesus fed over 15,000 people. Jesus has more power than the Old Testament prophets. Today we see people eating mana in the desert in the Old Testament. This mana took care of one's physical nature but not spiritual. Today Jesus says to the people, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will

never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." Jesus is the fulfillment of all our needs. The problems we have in this life can be healed by Christ. He may not take our problems away immediately but Christ can help us deal with our difficulties. Sometimes God allows problems to exist because we have something to learn from those problems. God does test us like he tested the Hebrew people in the desert. In testing, we grow stronger in our faith. We learn to depend on Christ and not ourselves. School starts in twenty-three days. Get your school clothes and notebooks. But first enjoy the rest of the summer. I am always looking ahead and that is a necessity but I believe God wants us to stay in the present moment. God speaks to us in the present moment but sometimes we are to occupied with the world by looking ahead. God is in the now. The latter is yet to be discovered. Masses during the weekday are at 8am. Children, at the last school mass I know that I challenged you to come to mass during the week. I have seen some of you there. Come and hear the word of God and eat the bread from heaven. After the third absence due to work, the player is not permitted to play in a game until he/she returns to CCD class. All other reasons are unexcused. Parents, if your child is sick, please call his/her teacher/leader before class. If necessary, the Parish Council will review attendance or unexcused absence issues on an individual basis.
