**From the
Desk of
Fr. Matt**

Have you ever been asked to sign up for something or you voluntarily signed up for something and whatever is that your signed up for you thought you knew what you were signing up for and after signing up you soon discover what you thought you were signing up was not really what you were signing up for? I do not read minds, but I would venture guess all of us has done this

at least once signed up for something and later being surprised at what you signed up for. If you are like me, you can think of many examples of when you have done this. I think of the example of when you go to a restaurant, and you order based on the picture on the menu and when it your order comes out it looks nothing like the picture.

In our scriptures today we are given an invitation to discipleship and when we hear of an invitation to discipleship, I think our automatic response is to say ‘Yes’. We say ‘yes’ to this invitation without taking the time to think about what we are saying ‘yes’ to. We say because we believe it is the right thing to do but really do not pay attention to the details of what we are saying ‘yes’ to. What might we be missing in our invitation to discipleship today? Jesus instructs us in our scriptures today that we are to hate “father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, even” (Luke 14:26) one’s own life. This can seem like an odd description of discipleship being called on to hate. Being called to hate seems to be the opposite of what Jesus calls us to be about. We normally associate the opposite with Jesus, normally we associate love with Jesus. Has something changed?

No nothing has changed, a matter of fact we are still called to love, a matter of a fact we called to love through a special lens we are called to Christ’s love. What is Christ’s love? In our scriptures today Jesus instructs us to carry our cross. It is at Christ’s cross that we experience a self-giving kind of love, a kind of love that Christ calls for us to have for one another. The love we are called to have calls us to live differently, we are called to have this self-giving love for each other.

In scriptures today we are given an example of this call to love different. In our scriptures today Paul writes to Philemon. When Paul writes this letter, he is in prison and Philemon has sent his slave Onesimus to serve Paul’s prison sentence for him. Paul sends Onesimus back to Philemon, he sends him back with intention of not having him back as no longer as a slave but as a brother.

As we embrace the call to discipleship, may we also the Lord’s call to love different, may we embrace the call to live a self-giving love for each other.

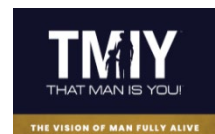
