- Uncover the Center Vestibule Stained Glass Window & Update Lighting
- Repaint the Church Vestibules, Sacristies, Restrooms, and Outside Doors

- New Parish Center Front Yard and Rectory Driveway Light Poles/Lighting
- Seal & Repaint the Blacktop around the Parish Center/Preschool

- New State Approved Preschool Playground Equipment
- Preschool Air Conditioning


## Church Fiber Glassing & Painting

- Work would be done by Conrad Schmitt Studios from New Berlin, Wisconsin.
- They have painted our church in the past, in 1921, 1942, & 1992.
- They also fiber glassed the exterior church walls in the mid-1990's & restored the Apostles in 2006.
- Fiber glassing helps extend the life of the paint. Our exterior walls are proof of that.
- In addition to repainting the entire church, the interior walls and ceilings will be fiber glassed.

### Church Hanging Lanterns

- The current art deco, hanging lanterns were put in during the mid-1960's.
- Each of the 11 current fixtures either use 500 watt or 750 watt light bulbs.
- The new hanging lanterns would be of a gothic style with a brass or bronze finish.
- Each new lantern would contain a LED light bar and only use 100 watts each.




# New Stained Glass Door Transom Windows

### **RESEARCHED PROJECTS** (PARISH CENTER)

#### Parish Center:

- Cafeteria:
  - Repaint the Green Tile Walls (Cafeteria and Hallway from the Kitchen to the Gym)
  - New, Bigger, Air Condition Unit and Duct Work
  - New Drop Down Ceiling
  - New Lighting
  - New Audio/Visual System
- Kitchen:
  - New Exhaust System
  - Kitchen Remodel (Epoxy Floor, Lighting, and Close in the area above the Stove Hood)

### **RESEARCHED PROJECTS** (PARISH CENTER) - CONTINUED

- Building:
  - New Hallway Carpet
  - Refinish all Wooden Doors
  - Update CCD Classroom Area Restrooms
  - Install Tinted and Insulated Glass into the Outside Doors
  - Air Condition for Rooms 26 & 28
- Gym/Stage/Gym Lobby:
  - Repaint the Green Tile Walls (In the Gym and the Hallways to the Gym Restrooms)
  - Update the Gym Lobby Restrooms
  - Air Condition for the Gym/Stage/Gym Lobby

## **MISC. INFORMATION**

- The Capital Campaign is being planned to Kickoff in April.
- The Projects are being divided into, two groups:
  - Needs and Enhancements with the needs being completed first.
- In each group the Church Needs or Church Enhancements will completed first, before the other areas of the Parish.
- The Diocese has given us permission to proceed with our Capital Campaign after Easter.
