- 1. The opening prayer was offered by Fr. Tony Fortman.
- 2. The October meeting minutes were read by the secretary. Motion for approval was made by Dale Warnecke and seconded by Lisa Meyer. The minutes were approved.
- 3. The museum in the Parish Center is complete, and a museum guidebook has been put together for sale.
- 4. The sacristy storm windows are back in and fixed. The company did not charge extra to straighten them.
- 5. The handicap door is finished, and an insert on it will go in with the bulletin.
- 6. The chimney work has been done, along with all necessary adjustments.
- 7. The Capital Campaign update as of 11-9-15 is \$639,164 pledged and \$418,676 paid. \$50,000 will be transferred into that account. These are funds that had been previously earmarked for church restoration.
- 8. The volunteer lunch is set for 12-6-15, with RSVP's requested by 11-30-15.
- 9. Help is requested for setting up the parish's Christmas in the Park display on Saturday Nov 21 at 8:30.
- 10. A request was made to have the choir's broken microphone replaced. It will be looked into.
- 11. A suggestion was given and agreed upon to put a direct deposit form insert in the bulletin.
- 12. The Finance Committee's annual internal audit went well.
- 13. We were informed that revisions have been made to update the cemetery rules. We will review them at a future meeting.
- 14. The choir donated a plaque in Tom Knapke's memory. It will be hung on the wall of the choir loft stairway.
- 15. Jerry Hanneman is planning to step down as business manager on 3-31-16. It is a part-time position with no more than 24.5 hrs/wk. In January/February the parish will need to look into hiring a replacement. Jerry will assist as needed to train.
- 16. The parish Christmas caroling is scheduled on Monday December 14 at 6:00 p.m.
- 17. The next meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 18 at 7:00 p.m.
- 18. Closing prayer was done by Fr. Tony.
